Dissertation: “The Ontology of Finance”

Abstract

My dissertation presents a twofold contribution to the development of a computational ontology of finance. In chapter one, I elucidate the practical applications of such an ontology, and I argue for ontological realism as the more appropriate methodology to build it. In the following chapters, I provide a metaphysical exploration of key financial entities. Such an investigation, in addition to being a resource for the ontology developer, solves some of the problems characterizing current debates in social metaphysics. In particular, in chapters two and three, I offer a characterization of financial transactions that does not have the limitations of the *Action Theory of Exchanges*. In chapter four, I offer a characterization of money that goes beyond the discussion about its physical (or abstract) nature.
